
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1. What is Shaping our Future about?

- We also need to plan for the future.




- More people will be living here and will need our services. This will cost more.

- Should we ask people to pay more for some services?







- Your councillors will take the important decisions about the future of local services.




 They will look at your ideas and listen to your views on what changes should be made.
