Destinations in and around Eskbank include Midlothian Community Hospital, Tesco Superstore and Edinburgh College's Midlothian Campus.

Eskbank is easy to get to by bus, with regular services to and from Edinburgh, East Lothian and the Borders, and cycling is easy with dedicated routes, many of which are part of the National Cycle Network.


Midlothian Health and Social Care Partnership aims to work with the public to improve our services, including those at Midlothian Community Hospital.

Finding your way around



Getting here by public transport



The map overleaf shows the main bus stops serving the hospital with frequency information for each route and contact details for each bus company, so you are able to find out departure times and fare details.

Service 139 runs every 30 minutes between the hospital's main entrance and Dalkeith, Woodburn and Thornybank on Monday to Saturday daytime. Service 339 runs every hour to Bonnyrigg, Newtongrange and Gorebridge.

The Community Hospital is served by the following bus services:

139, 339 call at the main entrance to the hospital - the bus shelter is closer to the hospital entrance than the car parking areas.

R1, R2, 49 and 140 call at the bus shelters on Eskbank Road. Access to the hospital from Eskbank Road is by way of two footpaths (one with steps, the other step-free). A pedestrian crossing on Eskbank Road makes it easy to cross the road to or from the Dalkeith-bound bus shelter.

29 calls at Tesco Superstore which is linked to the hospital via the pedestrian and cycle path across the footbridge over the A7 (or catch the 139 or 339 from Tesco to the hospital or the 49 or 140 to Eskbank Road).


N3 calls at the Muirpark bus stops on Eskbank Road.

Getting here on foot or by bike



Eskbank is a relatively flat area so walking and cycling to the Community Hospital is easy. The map overleaf shows the main pedestrian routes, and for cyclists, national cycle routes 1 and 196 run on the south side of the hospital site.





Regular bus services to the Community Hospital and Eskbank are provided by Borders Buses, East Coast Buses, Lothian Buses and LCTS.

All of these buses are able to carry passengers in wheelchairs. Please contact each company for bus times, fares and other information.
