James Abbott of Loanhead (1922 – 2008)

Biographical history

James 'Jim' Porteous Abbott was born in 1922 in Blackburn, West Lothian, the sixth of nine children. His family moved to Bowhill, Fife and then to Loanhead when Abbott was eight-years-old. He lived in Loanhead for the rest of his life. Inspired by his brother's love of brass band music, Jim Abbott started to play the cornet at a young age and joined Loanhead burgh band. He studied Music Harmony and Musicology at Edinburgh University and Foreign Correspondence with French and Spanish at Basil Patterson's College, Edinburgh. Abbott started his working life at MacTaggart, Scott Co Ltd, Loanhead and in 1939 joined the RAF and served in Europe and India. After the war, he declined a commission and soon formed his own dance band called 'Jimmy Abbott and the Music Makers' which performed throughout Scotland. In 1952, he became secretary of the Scottish Brass Band Association and then president of the Association in 1967, a post which he proudly held for 38 years. In 1990, he was awarded the MBE for his services to music. James Abbott was also a journalist and photographer. He wrote for local newspapers and took photographs at local events which were used in the local press. He married Hilary Kinrade in 1953 and had three daughters, Caroline, Gail and Louise. Towards the end of his life, he lived at Erskine House in Edinburgh and was cremated at Mortonhall Crematorium, Edinburgh on 17 January 2008.
