NOTICE OF ASSET TRANSFER REQUEST

An asset transfer request has been made to Midlothian Council under Part 5 of the Community Empowerment (Scotland) Act 2015.

The request has been made by Bonnyrigg Rose and relates to the **Poltonhall Sports Complex comprising of the Pavilion, Caretaker's Flat, car park area, grass pitches and artificial pitches.**

The request is for **ownership** of the assets.

The proposed use of the complex is to further develop the pavilion (including the caretaker's flat), upgrade the astro pitches and continue to develop positive working relationships with other community groups and organisations.
