The Orchard Centre Services (Health in Mind) are working closely with Bonnyrigg Rose football Club to help address the wellbeing needs of the people of our local community. The Club has taken very positive strides to ensure that they meet the mental health and wellbeing needs of its members as well as their Physical health needs.

The Club recently organised a Mental Health awareness seminar at the Polton Hall Pavilion, which was attended by over 60 people including those working in the field of Mental health, those receiving support and Club officials and coaches.

They are showing a certain amount of dynamism in helping to address and tackle a subject matter that still arouses a lot of suspicion and mistrust. Bonnyrigg Rose currently offer the use of their training pitches to our Men's SHARE Project members each week. This project supports over 30 young Men to address issues of social isolation and suicidal ideation. Health in Mind are very grateful for the help and support offered by the Club and hope to continue to work closely together to help reduce the stigma associated with Mental health and to bring together all cross sections of the community in the Bonnyrigg and surrounding districts.
