

DALKEITH/WOODBURN DECIDE

Residents in Dalkeith Woodburn are being asked to decide on how £60,000 of a Midlothian Council budget is to be spent.

The money can be used for capital projects on the theme of “Community Wellbeing”. This could include roads, pavements, parks, street lighting, potholes, playgrounds, sport pavilions and other public places and spaces.

Project examples might include:

- Village Gateway feature – welcome signage.
- Improving existing facilities – i.e. upgrading paths from gravel to tarmac.
- Christmas lights.
- Improved road safety measures - speed-activated signs.
- Pedestrian crossing – Zebra, Toucan or Pegasus crossing.
- Planting of an orchard.
- Park infrastructure - gates, fences, walls.
- Park furniture - benches, picnic benches, litterbins or interpretation boards.
- Play equipment for an existing play area - inclusive play or an outdoor gym or fitness equipment.

An idea must

- Come from Dalkeith/Woodburn residents – either as an individual or as part of a community organisation.
- Have a minimum cost of £10,000 (but don’t worry if you have no idea how much your idea will cost – we will help cost it).
- Be work that is within Dalkeith/Woodburn
