Allan Terrace

Properties in Allen Terrace which have shared drying greens at the back all have considerable amount of dog fouling and rubbish lying about in this shared area. There was also dumped items at main front door at another block of flats. One of the street lights was faulty on this stretch of road. Three properties in Allen Terrace had messy gardens and two of these properties also had large amounts of household rubbish in back garden area. There was a pot hole on the road.

Gibraltar Court

The street and road area were well maintained on the day of walkabout and no issues had been raised by residents prior to walkabout.

Surrounding area near lane going to back of old Dalkeith High School had signs of fly tipping with many household items been dumped in this area.
