NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that **MIDLOTHIAN COUNCIL** has this day made a Tree Preservation Order in respect of the tree contained within the area detailed in the plan and described in the First Schedule to the Order which accompanies this Notice.

The Council's reasons for making the Order are that the tree is a defining element in the local landscape and adds to the landscape character of Eskbank and Ironmills Conservation Area, and the setting of properties on Ancrum Road. The tree is visible from Ancrum Road and from Dalhousie Road (B6392), and therefore adds to the setting and amenity of the wider area. It is appropriate to protect the tree because of its importance in the local landscape.
