

# Scottish Parliament Election 6 May 2021

## Notice of Election for the Lothian Region

1. An election is to be held for seven members to serve in the Scottish Parliament for the Lothian Region.
2. Nomination papers can be obtained from the office of the Regional Returning Officer, Election Office, City Chambers, High Street, Edinburgh EH1 1YJ during the times stated below.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Regional Returning Officer at Election Office, City Chambers, High Street, Edinburgh EH1 1YJ between the hours of 10am and 4pm on any working day after the date of this notice but no later than **4pm on Wednesday 31 March 2021**.
4. If the election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday 6 May 2021**
5. Applications to register to vote must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on **Monday 19 April 2021**. Applications can be made online: **<https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>**.
6. The £500 deposit can be paid by legal tender or by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as a banker in the United Kingdom. **In the current circumstance it is requested that payment is made by direct bank transfer of funds. Bank account details will be provided on request.**
7. Applications for receiving new postal vote and postal proxy applications, and for changes to existing postal or proxy votes must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer at the address below by 5pm on Tuesday 6 April 2021.
8. Cancellations of postal votes must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Tuesday 20 April 2021.
9. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer at the address below by 5pm on Tuesday 27 April 2021.

10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election, i.e. made after the 27 April deadline on the grounds of; disability suffered after that deadline (or, for applicants who suffered a disability before the deadline, their disability meant that they could not reasonably have made an application in time), work/service reasons, **following Scottish Government advice or the advice of a medical professional in relation to coronavirus**, being detained in a hospital under the civil sections of the Mental Health (Care and Treatment) (Scotland) Act 2003 or for Scottish prisoners serving a sentence of 12 months or less, must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer at the address below by 5pm on Thursday 6 May 2021. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Tuesday 27 April 2021.
