Section 1: Our contact details

Section 2: Why we need your personal information?

To secure the safety and welfare of every child of school age and ensure that their education is directed to the development of the personality, talents and mental and physical abilities of the child or young person to their fullest potential.

Section 3: Legal Information

Processing your information is necessary to take steps to enter into an agreement to supply instrumental instruction.

Personal information being collected includes the following:

Child's name, parent or carer's name, school, contact telephone numbers and a contact email

Section 4: Sharing and transfer

We will be sharing the information collected in this form with your child's school and music instructor

Your personal information will not be transferred outside of the UK

Section 5: How long will we keep your personal information? (Records retention)

We keep your personal data collected from this form in accordance with our data retention schedules i.e.: for 5 years post-school. This data will be destroyed after this period. For further information, visit our website and search for Records Management.

Section 6: Your rights
