This walkabout took place on Monday 13 December 2021. The walkabout due to current restrictions with Covid-19 was advertised to tenants residing in this area of Penicuik. Eastfield Farm Road

On the day of the walkabout there was items dumped at the back of this street near the substation. At the parking bays there was also a trailer which appeared to have been left for some time with items stored near this. Going from this street into Ladywood Court there was a tree which was damaged.

Action: Reported to Contact Centre damaged tree and Housing Officer will follow up with items left near parking bays in this estate.



Windsor Drive

The street area was in a general tidy condition on the day of the walkabout but there was a few pot holes in the road and the pavement also had a few small holes with locals regularly parking their cars on them.

Action: Reported to Contact Centre faults with the road and pavement

Windsor Terrace

There was one garden in this street which had items dumped in it and was messy. At the back of this street there is garages which had an old metal pipe dumped there.

Action: Housing Officer to follow up with tenant regarding their messy garden. Reported to Contact Centre the item to be uplifted.
