The Access to Midlothian Card can be used by anyone to gain admission to Council leisure facilities at special discount rates. If you are in one of the categories listed overleaf you could get free or concessionary access. Other members of the public can buy a card and enjoy the same discounts.

The card can be used at Council leisure centres, swimming pools, tennis courts, bowling greens, putting greens. You are unable to use your card at Midlothian Snowsports Centre.

Applying for a card is easy. Simply complete the application form attached to this leaflet and take it to your nearest leisure centre or swimming pool where you will be issued with your card. If you are applying for free or concessionary access you will need suitable documentary proof of entitlement. Contact your nearest leisure centre for further details of required documentation.

Cards can also be purchased for a six-month or twelve-month period. The length of validity of The Access to Midlothian Card is dependent on the benefits received.

What you need to bring with you when you are applying for a new, renewal, or replacement card 1: Payment £4.90

- 2: 2 forms of entitlement (letter of award)
- 3: Proof of home address e.g. utility bill

To be eligible for any of the categories of the Access to Midlothian Scheme you MUST provide adequate proof of receipt of benefits to receive a card.
