Crichton Drive

Action: Reported to Contact Centre that the road sign is covered by greenery and badly needs to be trimmed back.

Crichton Avenue

On the day of the walkabout there was five messy gardens in this street area and one was already being dealt with by the Housing Officer. The path leading into the community garden space was badly overgrown with bushes and trees.

Action: Housing Officer will do follow up action with tenants with the messy gardens and pathway and perimeter of the community garden with overgrown trees and bushes reported to Contact Centre.

Crichton Terrace
