

## ASSET TRANSFER UNDER THE COMMUNITY EMPOWERMENT ACT NOTICE OF ASSET TRANSFER REQUEST

An asset transfer request has been made to Midlothian Council under Part 5 of the Community Empowerment (Scotland) Act 2015.

The request has been made by LASC Childcare Services LTD and relates to Roslin Pavilion (including the building, car park to the side of the building and land immediately to the rear, up to the existing fence).

The request is for a 50 year lease.

The lease will allow LASC Childcare Services LTD:

- To continue to provide breakfast and after school club care for children from the surrounding area.
- To open the facilities to local groups who could benefit from the use of the facility maximising the use of the space and facilities available in the building and surrounding area. By doing this they would integrate and develop the mid-morning, evening, and weekend activities for the community.
- To create job roles and help support developing skill sets which support employability through the introduction of a community café, sports facilities and potential inter organisational projects.
