Introduction

In this guide you will find information on the specialist housing options available for rent throughout Midlothian.

We have split the leaflet into different types of housing, explaining the level of support they provide, where they are located and how to apply either through the Council or a local Housing Association.

All of the homes allow pets but some may have restrictions.

You may find our leaflet 'Support to move, a guide for people in Midlothian' useful - it has hints and tips for each stage of moving house.

Please note that the demand for housing is high and it may take time to find a suitable home for your needs. We encourage you to apply as soon as possible, to keep your options of location as wide as possible and consider all housing options that are suitable for your needs.

MAINSTREAM HOUSING

General homes of any size or layout



WHEELCHAIR HOUSING

Fully accessible homes of varying sizes.



EXTRA CARE HOUSING (50+)

1 & 2 bedroom homes with onsite care staff and 24 hour alarm service.



AMENITY HOUSING (55+)

1 bedroom accessible homes near public transport and town centres.



RETIREMENT HOUSING (60+)

1 & 2 bedroom homes with some staff support and 24 hour alarm service.

Help & Advice about your Housing Options

Staying in your Own Home

If you need help to stay in your home because of a disability or ill health, you may be able to use specialist equipment or adapt your home. We can visit you to discuss this and assess if we can support you. If you are not eligible for support from the Council we may be able to direct you to other services.

If you have support from the Council and are moving house speak to us about support you will need in your new home. It is important that you plan well in advance to make sure that you have the right support when you move.

Mainstream Housing

Anyone over 16 can apply for a home of up to four bedrooms. These include flats, four in a block, semi-detached and detached properties.
