Ring & Go "CD"- Cousland, Southfield, and Langside to/from Dalkeith/Pathhead

Conditions of Scheme

Taxi/Private Hire Car journeys will be provided between Cousland, Southfield, and Langside to/from Dalkeith [Campus/Town Centre] or Pathhead.

Passengers

All passengers wishing to use this service must register with Midlothian Council and have a Ring & Go photo ID card with a user number. This number will be prefixed with the code "CD" for the Cousland area and must be quoted when the journey is booked with the operator.

Passengers do not have exclusive rights to travel alone in the vehicle and may be required to share if other bookings arise at the same time. Visitors may also use this service if they are accompanied on the journey by a registered passenger.

Operation of Service

The journeys will run as flexibly as possible. All journeys must be pre-booked with **Swift Taxis** by telephone on **0131 660 5000** or **0131 660 1031**.

Journeys can be booked several days in advance. Morning journeys must be booked by the day before. Evening journeys can be booked on the day itself up to one hour before travel.

You can ring with a short notice travel request less than an hour before you need to travel, however, the operator will only accept a short notice booking if it fits around existing bookings. If the operator is already busy with other bookings, then requests for short notice Ring & Go bookings will be turned down.

Persons travelling can be picked up or set down as required in the rural area and can travel to/from the specified areas within Dalkeith. The service is available from 07:00 to 22:00, seven days a week. There is no service on 1st, 2nd January or 25th, 26th December.

Fares and Receipts

All passengers aged 6 or over are charged for each single journey. Infants and children up to and including 5 years old travel free when accompanying a fare-paying passenger. Cousland-Dalkeith - £2.00, Cousland-Pathhead - £3.50.

There are no other discounts or concessions. The Scotland-wide free bus pass entitlement card is not valid on this Ring & Go service.

The taxi driver will ask to see your Ring & Go card marked with "CD" and you will be issued with a receipt.

The Dalkeith single fare on Ring & Go is equivalent to the adult single flat fare on Lothian Buses. The Pathhead single fare on Ring & Go is equivalent to the Borders Buses Ltd adult single fare from Pathhead to Dalkeith. Any rise in these bus fares will be reflected in the Ring & Go fares.

How Do I Apply?

Application forms can be obtained from Midlothian libraries including Dalkeith. There is also a supply of application forms in the Travel Team carousel in the foyer of the Pathhead Medical Practice. Completed application forms should be sent to:

Each applicant must enclose **one** colour passport-style photographs with the applicant's name printed on the back and a proof of address i.e. copy of Council Tax letter or utility bill.

There is no charge for the issue of a Ring & Go card. Cards are issued for four years after which the holder can apply for a renewal using the Ring & Go application form. No reminder is sent from the Travel Permits and Passes Team.
