# Ring & Go "PE"- Pathhead, Edgehead, Whitehill to/from Dalkeith Plus Fala, Fala Dam, Ford, Dewarton, Dalkeith Campus

## **Conditions of Scheme**

Taxi/Private Hire Car journeys will be provided between Fala, Fala Dam, Pathhead, Ford, Dewartown, Edgehead and Whitehill to/from Dalkeith [Town Centre/Campus].

# **Passengers**

All passengers wishing to use this service must register with Midlothian Council and have a Ring & Go photo ID card with a user number. This number will be prefixed with the code "PE" for the Pathhead-Edgehead area and must be quoted when the journey is booked with the operator.

Passengers do not have exclusive rights to travel alone in the vehicle and may be required to share if other bookings arise at the same time. Visitors may also use this service if they are accompanied on the journey by a registered passenger.

## **Operation of Service**

The journeys will run as flexibly as possible. All journeys must be pre-booked with **Swift Taxis** by telephone on **0131 660 5000** or **0131 660 1031**.

Journeys can be booked several days in advance. Morning journeys must be booked by the day before. Evening journeys can be booked on the day itself up to one hour before travel.

You can ring with a short notice travel request less than an hour before you need to travel, however, the operator will only accept a short notice booking if it fits around existing bookings. If the operator is already busy with other bookings, then requests for short notice Ring & Go bookings will be turned down.

Persons travelling can be picked up or set down as required along the line of the 51/52 bus route and can travel to/from the specified areas within Dalkeith. The service is only available at certain times to complement the existing 51/52 bus service operated by Borders Buses Ltd on behalf of Scottish Borders and Midlothian Councils.

The Pathhead- Edgehead Ring & Go service runs seven days a week: Monday to Saturday 6am - 8.30am then starting back up at 6pm-11pm, Sunday 6am - 11pm.

There is no service on 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> January or 25<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup> December.

Keeping to the following times allows the Ring & Go service to complement the 51/52 bus service without running at the same times as the buses. Ring & Go will wait for pre-booked passengers coming off buses from elsewhere if notified when the booking was made [e.g. Edinburgh or Royal Infirmary to Dalkeith by Lothian 48].

## Southbound from Dalkeith

0710, 0835, 2135, 2235 from Dalkeith Buccleuch Street

## Northbound to Dalkeith

0625, 0925, 2015, 2215, 2315 from Pathhead [Medical Centre at top of village]

If no-one is booked to travel from, say, the Dalkeith Campus, then the service can start at Buccleuch Street. If there is no-one booked to travel further than Edgehead southbound and no-one is booked for the return journey, then the vehicle will come out of service on reaching Edgehead. If no-one at all is booked on a journey, it will not run.

# **Fares and Receipts**

All passengers aged 6 or over are charged £3.70 for each single journey. Infants and children up to and including 5 years old travel free when accompanying a fare-paying passenger.

There are no other discounts or concessions. The Scotland-wide free bus pass entitlement card is **not** valid on this Ring & Go service. Tickets issued by Borders Buses Ltd are not valid on this service. One-Ticket is not valid on this service.

The taxi driver will ask to see your Ring & Go card and you will be issued with a receipt.

The single fare on Ring & Go is equivalent to the adult single bus fare between Dalkeith and Pathhead. Any rise in the Borders Buses Ltd bus fare will be reflected in the Ring & Go fare on the same date or soon thereafter.

#### How Do I Apply?

Application forms can be obtained from Midlothian libraries including Dalkeith. There is also a supply of application forms in the Travel Team carousel in the foyer of the Pathhead Medical Practice. Each applicant must enclose **one** colour passport-style photographs with the applicant's name printed on the back and a proof of address i.e. copy of Council Tax letter or utility bill.

There is no charge for the issue of a Ring & Go card. Cards are issued for four years after which the holder can apply for a renewal using the Ring & Go application form. No reminder is sent from the Travel Permits and Passes Team.

Please allow 15 working days for a card to be processed and posted, so please apply in advance for your renewal.
