



National Pool Lifeguard Qualification

The NPLQ covers all elements of Pool Rescue Techniques, Lifeguard Theory, First Aid and CPR. The course is physically demanding and will include swimming to set times, lifting casualties and diving to the deepest part of the pool. Approved prior learning can be applied upon proof of certification.

Emergency First Aid at Work (may include Emergency Paediatric First Aid)

Level 3 Emergency First Aid at Work qualification is a one-day course and includes theoretical classroom work and a practical assessment on CPR and first aid, enabling a first-aider to give emergency first aid to someone who is injured or becomes ill while at work. The course is suitable for all industries and enables employers to meet HSE requirements. On completion, candidates receive an RLSS UK Qualifications Level 3 Emergency First Aid at Work Qualification. Emergency First Aid at Work is endorsed by CIMSPA and the First Aid Awarding Organisation Forum.
