

Downloading eMagazines to your Kindle Fire/Fire HD



Install the app and Create a Zinio.com Account

Amazon.com has chosen not to list the app for Kindle Fire/Fire HD on their web store. However please follow the instructions below to download the Zinio app for your device:

1. Bring up the Settings menu on your KindleFire ('swipe' down from top right corner)
2. Select **More, Device**, 'Allow installation of Applications (from unknown devices)' and select **ON**.
3. Open a web page and download the APK (app installer) at:

Note: To show the download progress swipe down from the top left corner.

4. When the download has finished, you need to find it on your device. Open a web page and tap the menu button which appears at the top left of the screen. Select Downloads and locate the file.

Select **Install** and press **Open** when the installation is complete.



5. When the App opens tap on the 'open book' icon at the top of the screen. You will see a 'Welcome to Zinio!' message. You now need to create a Zinio.com account and to do this should tap on the **Not a member?** link.

6. Fill in your email address, select a password and opt to **Join Zinio**.
7. You will now also need to create a Library Zinio Account to borrow free titles.

Note: To find the app on your device the Apps page will need to be set to Device not cloud.

Create a Library Zinio Account

1. Close the app for now and open the eMagazines web page:

<http://www.rbdigital.com/midlothian/zinio>

Note: You may want to save this to your favourites as you will need to go into the website each time you want to choose titles.

2. Select to **Create New Account** (top right of the page) and enter your library card number.
3. When prompted enter your name, email address, create a password and click on **Create Account** (you will need to use the same email address as you did in zinio.com to link the accounts).

Selecting and Downloading titles

1. Open the eMagazines web page and **Log in** to your account at the top right corner (if not already logged in).
2. You can browse magazine titles on the home screen (there are 3 pages to scroll through) or select from the full range by tapping in the **Title Search** box.



3. When you find a title you want tap on the cover

5. You can now either read the magazine online, or download it to the App to read offline:

To read in your browser:

Choose to **Start Reading**

To read offline in the App:

Select **Keep Browsing**, close the web page and open the app to read the title.

Reading titles

1. Re-open the Zinio app  and you will see the selected title appear.

Note: If the title doesn't show automatically appear go to the menu tab at the top right of the screen and select settings, then **Refresh Library** then close the settings window. You should now see the magazine.

2. Tap on the cover to read.

Tips:

- To navigate through the magazine swipe the screen from right to left to turn the pages.
- Pinch out or in to zoom or double tap the screen
- To view double page spreads hold your device horizontally, or hold it vertically to see single pages.
- Tap the screen once to reveal individual pages along the bottom of the screen, and a table of contents icon at the top right of the screen.
